### Resource Management Act 1991

#### The Resource Management (Approval of Cyberstar of New Zealand Limited as Requiring Authority) Notice 1995

##### Notice

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Resource Management (Approval of Cyberstar of New Zealand Limited as Requiring Authority) Notice 1995.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its publication in the *New Zealand Gazette*.

**2. Interpretation**—In this notice, unless the context otherwise requires, “telecommunication” and “telecommunication link” have the same meaning as in section 2 (1) of the Telecommunications Act 1987.

**3. Approval as requiring authority**—Cyberstar of New Zealand Limited is hereby approved as a requiring authority for its operation, maintenance and development of a system comprising telecommunication links to permit telecommunication.
